It is the intent of the Stallion Owner/Manager to help settle your mare as quickly as possible.

The Mare owner is responsible for asking any further questions they might have regarding this agreement or the services provided.

1. The Mare Owner agrees to pay a Stud Fee in the amount of \$ _____ for the services of the Stallion listed above prior to shipping. Any multiple mare or early booking discounts will be calculated as follows: _____.
2. The Mare Owner agrees to pay a non-refundable Booking Fee in the amount of: \$ _____ with this agreement, or by the date: _____.
3. A deposit of \$ 300.00 is required for the shipping container and will be refunded after the container has been returned in good, reusable condition within 3 days following receipt of the semen. If a disposable container is utilized for shipment, a fee of \$40.00 will be withheld from the deposit.
4. The Mare Owner is responsible for any permit fees required for shipped semen or registration. The stallion Owner/Manager will file the necessary stallion reports.
5. A non-refundable Semen Collection Fee of \$200.00 per collection must be paid by the Mare Owner prior to shipment of semen, which is to be taken out of initial \$300.00 deposit.
6. Shipping (transportation of semen) fees are to be paid by the mare owner. The Stallion Owner/Manager will determine the best method of shipping and will notify the Mare Owner in advance of the charge. The Mare Owner is to notify the Stallion Owner/Manager two weeks prior to the planned breeding date and again by 12 noon the day before the transported semen is to be shipped. 7. implied. The semen must be administered by a licensed veterinarian/technician on the day of delivery or the Mare Owner shall not be considered to have fulfilled the contractual obligations.
8. In the event the mare fails to conceive after breeding through three heat cycles the Stallion Owner/Manager offers the following options:
 - a. The Stallion Owner/Manager assumes responsibility only to deliver Fresh Cooled Semen in viable condition at time of shipping to the mare's location for insemination. This agreement makes no warranties, expressed or Yes No A return breeding will be granted (without additional stud fees) for the same mare if the mare is examined by a licensed veterinarian and found to be barren at 21 days from the date of the last service. Applicable fees for collection, shipping and/or lab fees will apply to all return privileges.
 - b. Another mare may be substituted. The return breeding privilege will expire 24 months after the date of the first service to the mare named above.
 - c. The Mare Owner may send the mare to a designated breeding farm for reproductive evaluation and breeding. The Mare Owner is responsible for all transportation costs, and arrangements, any evaluation fees incurred and board at the breeding farm.

9. Live foal guarantee. Should the mare not produce a live foal that stands and nurses, the Mare Owner shall also be entitled return breeding privileges. This privilege shall apply only if the Stallion Owner/Manager is notified by registered mail within 48 hours of the foal's death. A statement of details by a licensed veterinarian must follow within 10 days or the privilege becomes null and void.
10. Limitations regarding the stallion include: Semen Collection will be performed on Monday, Wednesday and Friday only. During times of greatest demand, there may be days when semen availability is limited and semen delivery may therefore be delayed. Stallion Owner/Manager reserves the right to suspend semen collections during times of competition. Should the Stallion die, become unfit for serviceable sold, or unavailable due to uncontrollable circumstances, the stud fee will be refunded upon the Mare Owner's written request. Upon refund of the stud fee both parties will be released from this agreement which will then be null and void.
11. This agreement cannot be transferred by the Mare Owner in the event the mare is sold, leased or otherwise changes ownership after having been bred by semen from the Stallion, thus there will be no right to return.
12. The Mare Owner agrees that if the breeding contract is not used within the next two subsequent years, the contract will be considered null and void, and all fees will be forfeited.
13. Either party may nullify this agreement with just cause at any time and all fees paid will be forfeited.
14. This agreement shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State in which the Stallion resides.
15. The Mare Owner agrees to provide a copy of the Mare's pedigree and/or registration papers; Health Certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian certifying that the mare is in good physical condition, free from infectious disease, and in sound reproductive condition (including a current uterine culture taken in estrus no more than 60 days prior to scheduled breeding date) prior to semen shipment.
